2010 INTERNATIONAL PARIS MARATHON FULL **40 000 REGISTERED**

On Monday November 9th, 5 months before the 11th of April race, the organisers of the International Paris Marathon ended the registration period open to the public.

Once again, in two months the Marathon is already full. This early end to the registrations shows once again the craze the Paris Marathon provokes.

On Sunday the 11th of April 2010 at 8:45 AM at the Champs Elysées, the course will take the 40 000 competitors through the streets of Paris going past the Place de la Concorde, the Rue de Rivoli, the Bastille, the Bois de Vincennes, the Quais de Seine, the Trocadéro and the Bois de Boulogne before the finish line set at the Avenue Foch.

Like every year, Marathon Expo will open its doors before the event on the 8th, 9th and 10th of April. All the competitors will be able to collect their bib numbers and enjoy this special meeting place for all the actors involved in running. Close to 140 exhibitors will be present and like each year, the public (around 70 000 people last year) will be welcome to come for free to this place dedicated to running.
